FAKEnHATE: Detecting FAKE news and HATE speech" - Part 2

In this second seminar, I will address the other side of harmful information in social media: hate speech. I will first present the work done in collaboration with the Spanish observatory against racism and xenofobia. Hate speech is often conveyed covertly employing figurative language devices such as irony or sarcasm, and I will also show examples where hurtful humour was employed to spread prejudice in social media towards women and feminists, the LGBTIQ community, immigrants and racially discriminated people, and overweight people. Moreover, I will briefly present a study of the usage of stereotypes against immigrants by the members of the Spanish Congress of Deputies. Hate speech is a problem that needs to be addressed not only from a textual perspective and I will finally comment how the identification of misogyny in memes has been addressed.
